## Cowan Scowin' Regatta

The weather conditions were nearly perfect, with temperatures in the 70s and light but reasonably steady winds of 6-10 knots. 24 boats participated, including 5 with female skippers.

Race 1 got underway in a 10 knot northeasterly. The boats taking the right side had a distinct advantage, contrary to "local knowledge". Bill Christiensen did everything right, building a huge lead to take the win. Ted Keller (remember that name!) sailed to a solid second place followed by 1997 MC Nationals winner Dan Guidinger.

Race 2 was more typical, with the best strategy being to play the shifts up the middle. Curt Miller the '96 Cowan Scowin' winner did it best with Dan in 2nd and Ted in 3rd.

After the lunch break, Race 3 was sailed in a dying easterly of 6-8 knots. This race had the only general recall of the regatta, attesting to the great job the Race Committee did in setting the starting line. Some holes in the wind spread the fleet over the lake. Miller showed his mastery of the light conditions, pulling out to an easy win. There was a great battle for 2nd with Chris Craig, Carl Pratt and Keller crossing the finish line overlapped in that order.

Race 4 was a windward-leeward course. Chris Craig sailed to an apparent win, only to be awarded a DNF because of an improper gate rounding. Mindy Miller made no such mistake, winning the race in a hectic finish when the wind filled from behind - proving again that sailboat racing is an equal-opportunity sport. Steve Glawitsch finished 2nd followed by Keller.

Sunday's race was delayed until 10:30 AM when the expected southerly finally arrived. Keller got out front on the first leg and held the lead to the finish, giving him his first regatta race win. Craig and Pratt had a see-saw battle for 2nd, with Pratt hanging on to finish 2nd.

Wickland/Creed were the season winners of the Best 15 Race Award.
