

# 1st Annual SE Regionals

2/11-12, 1994, Fleet 4, Lake Eustis Sailing Club, FL

The Lake Eustis Sailing Club and its co-host, The Eustis Chamber of Commerce, initiated the first Southeast MC Regional Regatta on February 11 & 12. Fifteen entries from five fleets completed two of five scheduled races in shifty, variable, light winds of 4 to 8 miles per hour.

The finish was somewhat controversial when the RC started a race on Sunday after the noon deadline stipulated in the Race Instructions. Only the Lake Eustis skippers sailed the race, all others returned to the launching area and prepared their boats for the trip home; one filed a protest against the RC, which was upheld by the Protest Committee.

Lake Lanier's John Adams and Jim Gray took first and second with Peter Comfort of Torch Lake and Frank Keenan of Lake Eustis in a dead tie for third. Frank also took top honors in the Grand Masters while Tony Bruskas of Lake Davenport was the Masters champ.
