BOARD OF GOVERNORS MEETING APRIL 27, 1991, CHICAGO YACHT CLUB

Commodore Hardy Will called the meeting to order shortly after 9:00 am.

Present: Commodore Hardy Will, Vice Commodore Doug Stryker, Paul Richards, Scott Luce, Andy Carlson, Pam Cantrell, Curt Bradley, and Dave Porter of the Technical Committee.

Minutes of the Board of Governors meeting of June 20-21, 1991 and of the Annual Meeting on June 21, 1990 were read and approved with the addition that Tony Bruskas remains on the Technical Committee.

Executive Secretary's Report.

- Financial statement for 1990 read and approved.
- Membership and new fleets were discussed. One idea was advanced that fleets should require all members to join IMCCSRA. No action.
- Ex. Secty. will ask Melges Boat Works what the \$40 fee is for a new boat. (\$15 for IMCCSRA dues, \$25 for ILYA boat dues)
- A new Macintosh LC computer and Apple Personal Laserwritter have been purchase for use by the Ex. Secty. The Association paid half and Curt paid half. We will negotiate a buy-out by either party at the time Curt is no longer Ex. Secty.
- The Association's mailing list is probably the best in existance at this time. Curt has tried to include all names as they appear in regattas and in fleet lists. The Fleet Captains should submit a complete list of their roster including addresses and phone numbers at the time of the Executive Secretary's request for the annual report in December.
- If the Fleet Captain is not known, or does not respond, Curt is to contact the yacht club secretary for help.
- The Board authorized the use of full-page ads in the MC Newsletter at \$100 per page.
- Curt presented a rough layout of a 1991 yearbook which was approved, and which will be sent with the January 1992 MC Newsletter to all Association members as of November 1, 1991. A request was made to include telephone numbers that prompted the necessity of including that information on the membership blank that appears in the Newsletter. Phone numbers will be included in the 1993 Yearbook.
- We have a request from one of the boat builders to eliminate the reserving of boat numbers. No action.

Technical Committee

 Andy has investigated and found that Melges Boat Works puts in 6.22 cubic feet of flotation material which includes the hull foam. This is the next highest amount per displacement of all but the M-20.

It was moved and approved that we require 7.0 cubic feet of measurable flotation (exclusive of hull foam) in all boat built after January 1, 1992. The Technical Committee was directed to prepare the appropriate By-Laws change(s) for a vote at the Annual Meeting.

The Board recommends that all owners upgrade their flotation as a safety measure. Andy will prepare an article for the MC Newsletter outlining how owners can upgrade their flotation with styrofoam.

Race Management

•Doug has input from Ernie French on regatta management, as well as the previously approved Regatta Guidelines of IMCCSRA, and pertinent ILYA literature. He will combine these various sources into one Regatta Management package that will specifically cover the Mid-Winters and the National Championship as well as provide a resource for fleet management of local regattas.
