How many of you have ever been to a four-day regatta where the weather conditions couldn't have been better? Excellent winds, plenty of sunshine, and only a short delay in one race waiting for the morning southwesterly to fill in. That's what the 150 plus skippers experienced this 60th Annual Western Michigan Yachting Association regatta. This regatta rotates between five of the 18 member clubs - Spring Lake, Grand Rapid, Torch Lake, Crystal Lake, Muskegon and features Es, Cs, MCs, Lasers and Butterflies (Jr. and Sr.). This year saw the greatest number of MCs racing an entire series -- 74. There were 79 at the Diamond Lake Nationals three years ago but the fleet was split into Gold and Silver after three qualifying races. Chuck Harrett did a great job of setting good long lines and courses long enough to minimize windward and leeward mark traffic jams.

Two bullets and consistency spelled success for White Lake's Doug McNeil. The master's first place went to another local skipper, Tom McMurray.

Next year's regatta will be at Holland, Michigan's Macatawa Bay YC with the Grand Rapids YC serving as host.
