to sail with experimental charges for no more than one year. Laing that time, these yachts shall be certified as MC scows eligible for all sanctioned regattas. The Technical Committee's duties shall be reviewed from time to time by the Board of Governors and may be amended at any time by the Board.

- 2. ART. II Sect. 1 Change to read "not less than 6." Sect. 2 - Change to "Sect. 3." New Sect. 2: No candidate for election to the Board of Governors shall have any affiliation or connection with any builder of the MC Scow. If during his term of office any Governor becomes affiliated or connected with any byilder of the MC scow, he shall immediately resign from the Board of Governors.
- 3. ART. V Sect. 1: Change to read "The Fleet Treasurers shall annually, in the month of February or March, collect and pay over to the Corporation Treasurer or Executive Secretary, the dues of each named owner, as fixed by the Board of Governors." (Last sentence re non-fleet members remains unchanged.)
