April 14-16, 2000 Fleet 5 Rush Creek Yacht Club, Texas

Andy Burdick provided the following interesting notes on each race, as well as analyzing tactics and tuning for each condition.

Race 1. 8-15 mph breeze, 65 degrees.

The port side of the line and the course looked good. Andy followed Bill Jackson around the top mark. Downwind you had to really concentrate on where the shafts of breeze were coming down the lake. You had to be left on the final beat so Andy staved left of Slocum on every tack. Gust was headed for the 3rd spot but his hiking strap broke and Kern took the 3rd.

What was fast? You had to be in the breeze upwind and downwind. I (Andy) kept his traveller centered, pulled on vang and a bit of cunningham as the wind strengthened. Hiking hard in the puffs generated top speeds. Downwind sailing to leeward of wind was fast, especially to get into new wind. Easing the vang helps when doing this.

Race 2. Andy took on crew as the wind got up to 15. He stayed on starboard though those to the right were doing better. Finally tacking he found a big left shift and covered those on the right. However, Slocum found a big lift and eventually won this race.

What was fast? Staying in phase with the shifts. Not a lot of vang was fast. You were able to sail low and still go fast. Heading up to get into the breeze was key. You had to keep looking over your shoulder to spot the shots.

Race 3. Staying in phase was key, because it also meant more pressure in this race. Greg Gust with a good start won the race and Andy finished 6th.

Race 4. Port end of the line was favored and Scott Tillema took advantage of this fact and port tacked the fleet. You had to stay in the pressure as it mean 10 degrees of pointing if you did. Andy rounded the top mark 2nd to Zak Clayton. Downwind sailing to leeward and working the waves was key. In order to not nose dive you have to live on the edge and let the boat heel. Moving your weight back only drags your transom. You have to lean out and let the boat carve.

Clayton got a big lift into the mark to lead all the boats there. On the final beat Andy tacked at least 20 times but could not be caught and Andy finished 2nd.

What was fast? Being in phase, always sailing a lift. A flat sail was good in the small chop. So, lots of vang and even the traveller

down 6 inches in the puffs with a trim was good. You could really trim hard to bend the spar and flatten the sail with the vang. By the end of Race 4 the top sailors were in order, Andy, Slocum, Gust, Bowers,
