1999 MC Midwinter

February 12-14, 1999 Fleet 4 Lake Eustis SC, Florida

The 1999 MC Scow sailing season got off to great start with the years first event, the Midwinter Championship held at the Lake Eustis Sailing Club, Florida.

30 boats attended the event at the all-new Fleet 4 facility. Here are some highlights from the event.

Regatta Chairman Bob DeWitt and his team that included Frank Keenan, Greg Murphy and many others really put on a fine regatta. This year's event was sailed out of the clubs's new facility which was a pleasant change from years passed. The new property has over 500' of shoreline and on about 3 acres. New blacktop paving and new docks were ready and waiting for us upon arrival. 40 buoys with 40# cement anchors, Vectran line and Styrofoam buoys were also in place. The new hoist for this year Jack Kerns K-Mart purchased block and tackle which worked just fine on one of the local live oak trees. Next year we will see their new electric hoist up and running. There is 200' of pier already installed with more planned.

There were a number of alligators around but they were more scared of us than we were of them. Gators are only really dangerous when you feed them or have small pets near the waters edge. They do not hang out in the lake offshore which makes everyone feel much better.

Our Saturday night dinner was supposedly gator (according to the local leg pulling hosts) but we are pretty sure it was roast beef and pork.

Seven races were held in conditions from zero to the low 20s (MPH) with three races on Friday, three on Saturday and one on Sunday The first race was in light air followed by two races in medium air with huge velocity swings but somewhat steady in direction. Temperatures were in the 70s. Day two races were a bit more windy and colder with huge swings in direction and velocity. The final day of

racing was cold and windy. All seven races were 4.5 mile in length with half-mile legs on W 2-1/2 courses.

Racing was tough with a couple of lead changes during the event and lots of swings in point standings. Races winners included Race 1 Eric Hood, Race 2 and 3 Greg Gust, Race 4 and 5 Jack Kern, Race 6 Kelly Reese, and Race 7 Ted Keller.

Going into the last race several sailors could still win the regatta. Kern had a 3-point lead over Gust, who had a 1-point lead over Krawcheck. When the dust settled Greg Gust with a 3rd took the regatta honors.

Mark your calendars for March 10-12 for 2000. Greg Murphy, regatta cochairman for next year tells us you will be able to attend the Sarasota E/MC Regatta the following weekend. This has been worked out by both clubs. See you there.

Again, job well done to the group at the Eustis Sailing Club for hosting such a great event. We all know the consensus is to be back at Eustis for the 28th Annual Midwinter Championship next year. Hopefully the weather channel will not scare everyone off. This year it was false alarm and surely some sailors cancelled missing one of the best MC Midwinters ever held.
