Competition was close. On Saturday morning the wind rolled 30 degrees from South-Southeast to South in 10 minutes, producing difficult starting conditions for an eager fleet. The 2nd Race produced classic SSW White Lake breezes with puffs that undid five surprised competitors.

After a traditional White Lake lunch, Race 3 was the longest of the Regatta, an hour and ten minutes from Long Point to Lakeside Cove and back, allowing racers a chance to surf on White Lake's treasured yacht wakes, getting everyone in the mood for the upcoming WMYA Regatta at Spring Lake. The 4th Race was conducted along the south shore into a dying westerly and was shortened by a benevolent race master.

Sunday the fleet awakened to a la Nina easterly which persisted. The racers rounded the windward mark in the easterly and handled the inevitable 180 degree shift on their downwind leg. Chad Hough, who finished 5th, said "This is not a race!" But, Brian McMurray (1st) and Larry Brand (2nd) thought otherwise.

The final race of the Weersing allowed the sailors the Zen experience of a windward mark under Sylvan Beach to complete their White Lake adventures. The first finisher crossed the line at 1 PM. Trophies were awarded at 2 PM.
