Andy Burdick Sails To 5th MC Scow National Championship

With incredible consistency, especially in the company of a record 104 fellow competitors, Andy Burdick won the 1992 MC Scow National Championship. This makes the 5th consecutive year that Andy has won this regatta.

White Lake Yacht Club put on an outstanding regatta in strong winds out of the northern quadrants for the first two days and gentler, warmer winds out of the south on the final day of racing.

Whether it was the tail-end of Hurricane Andrew or premature September weather, the competitors had plenty of wind (and rain).

Registration and a tune-up race took place on Wednesday, August 26th. Two races were sailed on Thursday, three on Friday, and two on Saturday for a seven race, one throw-out regatta.

Highlight of the awards ceremonies was the presence of MC co-designer and America's Cup helmsman Buddy Melges to hand out the trophies. And, Gloria Melges, Buddy's wife and Commodore of the Lake Geneva YC, added her experience to the the Race Committee on the final day of racing.

Individual race winners were Brett Hatton of Spring Lake, Michigan the 1st and 6th races, Burdick of Zenda, WI the 2nd and 3rd races, Terry Neff of Minneapolis the 4th race, Dan Guidinger of Pewaukee, WI the 5th race, and Chad Gould of Oxford, Ohio the 7th race.

Top Amateur honors for the second year in a row went to Chad Gould, a graduate student at Ohio University. Gould finished 2nd overall as he did in 1991. Hatton finished 2nd amateur, third overall; Brian McMurray followed in 3rd amateur, 4th overall.

Top junior (24th overall) was Brian Fox of Spring Lake. Amy Eggert (28th overall), also from Spring Lake, captured top woman honors. The Masters (over 50) trophies went to Paul Eggert 1st, Spencer Weersing, Montague, Michigan 2nd; and Duane Pierson of Whitehall 3rd.

Trophies for the top Grand Masters (over 60) went to Duane Pierson of Whitehall, Michigan followed by Tom Getz, Moline, Illinois.

Eric Hood had this to say about sailing in big fleets and this first-ever 100-plus MC fleet. "I started the regatta with a 29th in the first race. Having sailed in big fleets of more than 100 boats, I knew that still doing well was possible, with or without a drop race. My goal was to finish in the top ten every race after that 1st race. By race seven, I had five top ten finishes and a 29th, this put me in fourth with a shot at second or possibly dropping back to sixth. My point; do not ever give up, work on consistent finishes in big fleets and you will do well. What a great regatta and good time we had! My thanks go to Tom Getz and all the members of the White Lake Yacht Club."
