1993 MC NATIONALS

June 9-12, 1993, Fl. 32 Windycrest SC, Lake Keystone, OK

Despite a record high water mark (34 feet above normal) just three weeks prior to this year's International MC Class Sailboat Racing Association's 1993 National Championship Regatta was held without a hitch. And, just to further complicate matters, Mother Nature threw six or seven tornadoes at the area the evening prior to the first races! The Windycrest Sailing Association and MC Fleet # 32 did an outstanding job of hosting the 65 skippers, their crews and spectators, providing excellent racing and off-the-water meals and activities. One of the event highlights was an interesting and informative talk by Mark Christensen of Bower Sails and an Olympic sailor.

Windward leeward courses and an equal number of Olympic courses were laid out by the Race Committee. Winds varied from 10-12 MPH on Thursday and Saturday providing light air tests, while Friday's 15 to 20 winds brought out the crews.

1st Race: Peter Comfort started at the port end of the line, was able to flop onto port go all the way to the right and commanded the lead throughout.

2nd Race: Gary Verplank pretty much repeated Peter's tactics; port end start, go right and head for the top pin. Jack Hattendorf in #907 had the lead most of the way to the top pin until he (Jack) tacked back to the middle of the course and Gary was first around and led all the rest of the way. He had a scare near the finish line when his wind died, and Scott Slocum and another boat came charging up in a vein of wind. Gary did get the win.

3rd Race: Brien Fox opted for a lee end start, flopped to starboard tack and covered the fleet all the way to win this last Friday race.

4th Race (Friday morning): Greg Gust who has been sailing an MC for just five months, started near the lee end of the line and went left to pick up the geographical wind shift. He led to the finish line, although he got a scare rounding the last leeward mark when his nearest competitor rounded and was pointing 30 degrees higher.

The 5th and 6th Races (Friday afternoon): Andy followed his boss's advice (see Sailing Smart by Buddy Melges) by getting off the middle of the line in a nice sag, powering up and going fast all the way. Mike Miller led Andy around the 1st and 2nd marks in the 5th race. Andy was able to break cover on the last leg and go on to win the 5th race.

7th Race (Saturday morning): After an abandonment, another race was started and Mark Christensen started at the lee end of the line, went all the way to the left shore on port, tacked to starboard and found he was laying the windward mark. Brian Fox chased him all the way to finish second.

Andy Burdick, for the fifth year in a row, became the 1993 MC National Champion. The Amateur Championship went to Terry Neff of Minneapolis, MN and the Minnetonka YC. 2nd and 3rd place amateurs were Greg Gust, Rockwell, TX and Rush Creek YC, TX; and Mike Miller, Bourbonnais, IL and Cedar Lake YC, IN. Debbie Ziegler, Hartland, WI and Pewaukee YC, WI (19th overall, 15th amateur) won Top Woman honors followed by Katic Reese, Ingleside, IL and Lake Geneva YC, WI; and Laura Barnes, Tulsa, OK and Windycrest SC. Brien Fox, Grand Rapids, MI and Spring Lake YC, MI captured junior honors with a 9th overall, 6th amateur record. Brien was followed by Peter Comfort, and Joe Novak, Grand Rapids, MI and Spring Lake YC, MI.

The top three Masters (over 50) were Gary Verplank, Bill Freytag, Fontana, WI and Lake Geneva YC, WI; and Zack Troxel, Dallas, TX and Rush Creek YC. Top Grand Masters (over 60) were Bill Freytag, Tom Getz, Moline, IL and White Lake YC, MI; and Curt Bradley, Grand Rapids, MI and the Grand Rapids YC.

The host club also offered a trophy for the top single-handed sailor which went to Drew Mize of Arlington, TX and the Arlington YC. Drew finished 15th overall and 11th amateur.

21 of the 47 IMCCSRA fleets were represented at this year's regatta. The host club had 13 boats entered followed by Rush Creek with 8, Pewaukee with 6, and Lake Geneva, Grand Rapids, Minnetonka, and White Bear all made the 800-900 mile trip with 4 boats each.
