1987 MC MIDWINTER CHAMPIONSHIP REGATTA LAKE DORA, MT. DORA, FLORIDA MARCH 6-8, 1987

30 MC's competed, coming to Florida from Illinois, Wisconsin, Iowa, Minnesota, Georgia, Texas, Michigan, Colorado & Florida. Friday races were cancelled due to wind — and lots of it! — as conditions were overcast with strong gusts to 40 mph., and eager racers were capsizing even before the starting gun. Saturday races were also cancelled due to rain — and lots of it! — as conditions ranged from rain/overcast/clearing(hopefully — but too briefly) to tornado warnings. Not to be undaunted, Sunday races started early, but the wind rapidly built during the 1st race to about 20 mph; the 2nd race was completed, with most racers being aided by crew members; and a 3rd race had to be cancelled, as the winds continued to gust. Despite all, David Koch of Pewaukee, WI won the Johnson Perpetual Trophy with skilful boat handling, and Bill Gilmer of Gainesville, GA came away with the Masters 1st place award.
