Paul Richards, Gary Verplank, Happy Fox, Glen Walborn, Dave Hough, Pat O'Brien and Scott Caston made up the remainder of the first ten in the 38 boat fleet.

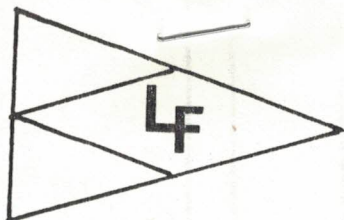
November 19 - the deadline for air bag flotation. Foam flotation will be required in all boats after this date.

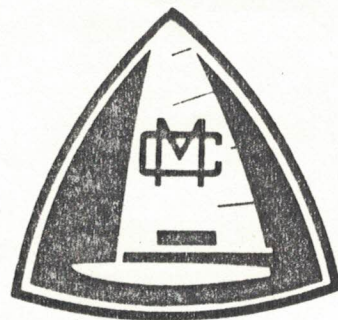
