

Notice of Race
James Island Yacht Club Regatta
James Island, South Carolina
June 20 - 21, 2009

1. This regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the Sailing Instructions, and Class Rules except where such class rules are amended by the Sailing Instructions.
2. The regatta is open to yachts of all classes. Classes with four or more boats entered may compete as a class. Sea Island One Design and all Junior classes need only three boats entered.
3. Registration will be at James Island Yacht Club, Friday, June 19, 1800 - 2100 and Saturday, June 20, 0900 - 1100.
4. Warning signal for the first race Saturday will be 1230 for the Junior course and 1255 for the 2 Open courses. Warning signal for the first race Sunday will be 1155 for all courses.
5. Sailing Instructions and course diagrams will be available at registration.
6. The regatta will be scored with the low point system as described in RRS, Appendix A as amended to read that a minimum of five races must be sailed before a score is discarded. This changes rule A2.
7. The penalty for breaking a rule in RRS, Part 2 for boats in the Sea Island One Design Class shall be a 360 (including one tack and one gybe). This changes rules 44.1 and 44.2.
8. Advertising will be limited to Category A.
9. Entry fees are as follows: \$10 Juniors, \$23 single, \$26 double, \$ 33 three or more. There will be a \$3 discount for proof of US Sailing membership at registration.
10. The decisions of the judges will be final, in accordance with RRS 70.4.
11. The number of trophies awarded will be determined by the number of boats entering each class, as described in the Sailing Instructions.
12. James Island Yacht Club will not be held responsible for any injury occurring on the clubgrounds or on the water during this event.
