MC Masters Championship, Gull Lake, MN, June 23-25, 2022

Greetings MC Sailors!

We are so excited for the 2022 MC Masters on Gull Lake!! Here are a few updates regarding mooring, launching and covid. Thank you and See you Soon!

Mooring: We will be primarily dry sailing. There is ample room for mooring directly in front of the club with a buoy and line at 6-10 ft with a sand bottom. There is a dock, but not all will be able to moor at the dock. Shuttle boats will be available to get to the boats moored on buoys. There are also 12 club buoys in front available for daytime and overnight mooring. Bring your own anchor, line and buoy. There are no tie downs in the parking lot. Dry sailing in the parking lot overnight is a good option.

Launch/Haul Out:

A greeter will provide you with a number for your trailer.

Go to your location in the parking lot and prepare your boat.

A power wash station will be ready for you prior to launching your boat in Gull Lake.

When ready to launch, the launch crew will bring your boat and trailer to the lake with a tractor.

Your boat will be put into the water and then you can tie to the dock or shuttle to a buoy.

The tractor will return your trailer to the parking lot.

Haul Out will be the reverse.

Shuttle from a buoy or tie to the dock.

Wait your turn and provide the launch team with your trailer number.

The tractor will get the trailer and bring it down to the landing.

You and the launch team will take out the boat and return the boat and trailer to the parking lot.

Parking: Parking cars in the lot is permitted. There also is parking available in the open lot adjacent to and east of the parking lot.

Camping: There are a few camping spaces on the west side of the clubhouse. Campers are requested to use the facilities in the lower level. There are no electrical or water hook ups.

Covid: We will rely on the Minnesota Department of Health recommendations for our gathering. https://www.health.state.mn.us/diseases/coronavirus/prevention.html#gather

We will be hosting our event with the majority of activities taking place outside. Indoor spaces will have improved ventilation with open doors and windows when possible. Three buffet style meals will be served indoors with seating available indoors and outdoors. Boxed lunches are planned for Thursday and Friday. Hand hygiene and disinfected surfaces indoors will be our standard. For your information Gull Lake Sailing School/ Yacht Club is in Crow Wing County. From the MN Dept of Health: It is up to all of us to protect ourselves and others. It is best to do multiple things to protect yourself when and where you can. Get vaccinated. Get a booster. Get tested if symptomatic. Stay home if you are sick. Quarantine (stay home and away from others) if tested positive. You may also choose to wear a well fitting mask at any time based on personal preference. Wash your hands. Maintain improved ventilation throughout indoor spaces when possible. Clean and then disinfect surfaces.
